Dear **Foothills County Council**

The Frank Lake Stewardship Committee is writing to you, requesting the ability to access the Community Clean up Grant for Frank Lake, in the amount of \$500-\$1000. We have been dealing with illegal dumping on different fronts. One said item was a couch and other trash on 530 ave East (please see attached images). We are very grateful for the county coming out and removing such items for us.

The next issue is the illegal dumping of carp (please see attached image). The image I have taken, does not show the full extent of the illegal dumping. Due to carp being an invasive species at Frank Lake, if you catch them, you must remove and dispose of the carp. There are individuals just leaving the carp around on the ground.

We are working with Ducks Unlimited Canada, on a solution which they have left for us to present them with a proposal. Ducks Unlimited Canada has agreed to put up metal signage, then the paper signage currently at the outflow. But in the mean time, we need to clean up the mess before the spring thaw, or the area will have a pungent odour. We must also make sure we are following Alberta invasive species disposal for the current mess.
